

AGREEMENT FOR RECIPROCAL MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES
BETWEEN THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL SOCIETY
AND THE SOCIEDADE BRASILEIRA DE FISICA

The American Physical Society (hereafter, APS) agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica, and the Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the APS.

- 1) Members of the Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica may submit papers to APS meetings with the same privileges and limitations as APS members;
- 2) Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica members may register at APS meetings at member rates; and
- 3) Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica members may subscribe to APS journals at the same rates as members of other member societies of the American Institute of Physics (AIP).


Conversely,

- 1) Members of the APS may submit papers to Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica meetings with the same privileges and limitations as Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica members;
- 2) APS members may register at Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica meetings at Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica member rates; and
- 3) APS members may subscribe to Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica journals at the same rates as Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica members.

This agreement shall remain in effect for a minimum of two years following the latter of the two dates, after which time the terms of the agreement may be reviewed, renegotiated, renewed or terminated if either Sociedade Brasileira de Fisica or APS so desires.
