It is our pleasure to announce that the **36th International Colloquium on Group Theoretical Methods in Physics (Group36)** will be held in **Valladolid, Spain, in July 13-17, 2026**.

This series of conferences, with a long-standing tradition, brings together researchers from mathematics, physics, and related disciplines to discuss the latest developments and applications of group theoretical methods.

As part of the colloquium, **the 2026 Weyl Prize and the 2026 Weyl–Wigner Award** will be presented to their recipients during a special Award Ceremony.

Topics

The scientific program will include plenary lectures, invited talks, parallel sessions, and poster presentations in areas such as:

- Group theory in physics.
- Mathematical physics and related fields.
- Quantum mechanics, quantum field theory, and beyond.
- Quantum groups.
- Quantum optics, quantum computing, quantum information.
- Representation theory and applications.
- Supersymmetry.
- Symmetries and conservation laws in physics.

Venue

The conference will take place in **Valladolid, Spain**, a historic city located in the heart of Castilla y León, well known for its cultural heritage, gastronomy, and lively atmosphere.

Valladolid is very well connected to Madrid by high-speed train (Renfe, Avlo, Ouigo), with a journey time of about one hour and numerous daily departures. In addition, the ALSA bus line connects Madrid-Barajas Airport directly with Valladolid, with travel times ranging from approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes on the express service to around 3 hours and 45 minutes on routes with additional stops.

Accommodation

Special rates have been negotiated with several hotels in Valladolid for conference participants. Details will be available on the conference website.
